As you are aware, the Ayushman Bharat – Health and Wellness Centres (AB-HWCs) are envisioned to bring the comprehensive primary healthcare at the doorsteps of the population. As we gear up towards achieving the stipulated targets for this financial year, it is important that we focus on the quality of healthcare services being provided at these centres.

The four regional workshops conducted involving all the States/UTs in the last few months were helpful in gauging the impact, these AB-HWCs have begun to make. The ranking of States based on the operationalization of AB-HWCs which was released in April this year for the FY 2018-19 (copy enclosed) gave us the starting point for conducting these workshops.

To move forward, it is decided that ranking of States will be released every month based on the performance of the States/UTs on the indicators (mentioned in the annexure) as elucidated based on the update done by the States/UTs in the AB-HWC Portal on the achievement of functionality criterion and regular daily reporting and monthly service delivery reporting. Please find enclosed the ranking of States for the month of September 2019 based on this criteria.

This will be an opportune moment for the States/UTs to ensure the quality and authenticity of the data by all means, as the AB-HWC portal will be used for future rankings. Further, the indicators related to service delivery for RCH and NCD will be included in ranking form Jan 2020 onwards, based on improved utilization of IT applications and status of data integration with HWC portal.

We would look forward to your inputs and suggestions for continuously evolving and progressing towards provision of comprehensive primary health care services at these AB-HWCs in the path towards Universal Health Coverage.
